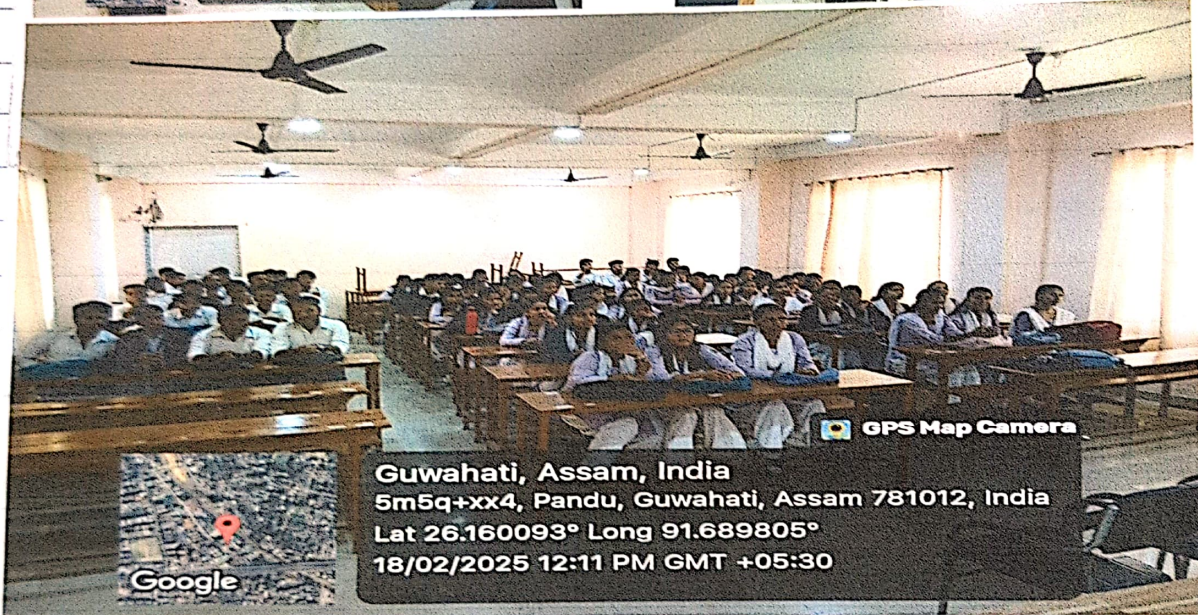
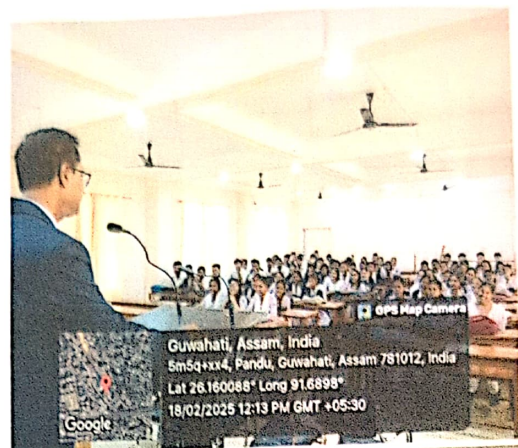

in managing their finance effectively. G)

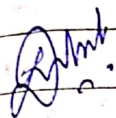
Many students expressed interest in learning more

practical skill that will be beneficial both in

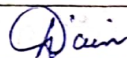
