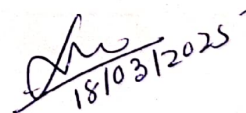
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Celebration of World Poetry Day – Invitation to Participate

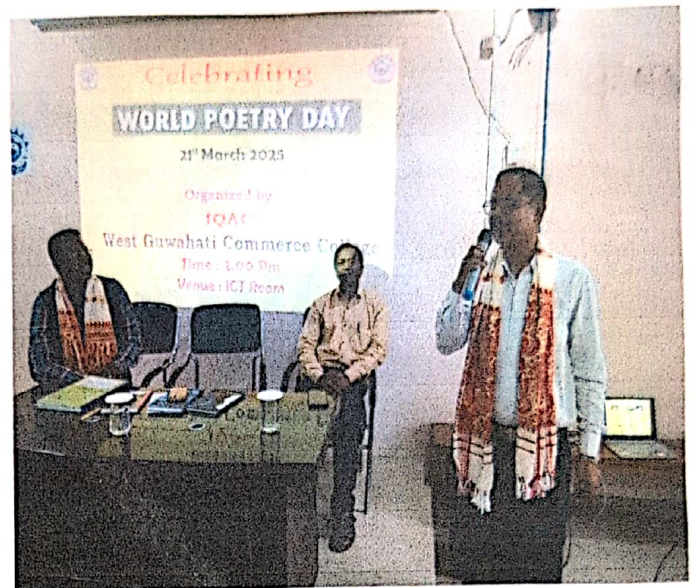

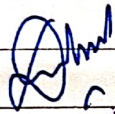
The event achieved the following outcomes—
