

Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP)


The Four - Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) of Gauhati University is as per UGC's Curricular, Framework, published in November 2022.

Duration: The NEP's FYUGP is a 4-year degree programme.

Extra & Entries: In the FYUGP, one has choice to exit from the programme thrice - after one year, after two years, and after three years. If one exits the programme after one year, one gets a certificate. If one exits after two years, one gets a diploma. If one exits after three years, one gets a Bachelor's Degree. And finally if a student completes the whole 4-year, one gets a Bachelor's Degree (Honours).

Progression:

If a student complete the FYUGP after 3 years, s/he will need to take admission into the first year of a Master's programme, which is a 2-year degree programme. However, if a student fully completes an FYUGP, she/he needs to take admission into the second year of a Master's programme and needs to complete only one year to get a Master's Degree. Under CBCS, there was no such pathways.





Syllabus: To be implemented from 2025 Newly Admitted FYUGP and FYIMP: (From August 2025)

1st and 2nd Semester of all the specialisation/major-B.com (Accountancy), B.COM (Finance), B. Com (HRM), B.COM (Marketing) will be same.

- * Students Interested in pursuing Degree in WGC College will have to register both in SAMARTH and college Admission Portal consecutively.
- * Students have to visit portal of Directorate of Higher Education (DHE) and create a UNIQUE ID by registering in the portal which is mandatory (url: http://dheonlineadmission.amtron.in/sp/#registration)
- * Students also have to Sign Up in Digilocker and create the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) ID which is mandatory.

STUDENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

Attendance:

Regular attendance in all the classes is mandatory for the Students. Students having a minim um of 75% are declared as regular and are allowed to appear in Council and University exam. If a student has an attendance percentage below 75%, he/she shall be treated as non-collegiate. Moreover, a student failing to attend 60% of the total classes would be declared as dis-collegiate. If a student fails to attend classes for 25 days at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes, he/she will forfeit his/her seat.

Discipline among Students:

Students are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline in the college campus. The college authority lays down certain rules and regulations, violation of which may make a student liable for disciplinary action. Any will fuldamage of college property would be treated as a serious offence and stern action will be taken in this regard.



Wearing of prescribed uniform in the college campus is mandatory for each and every student. Astudent breaking the uniform code would not be allowed to enter the college premises. It is also compulsory for each and every student to wear uniform during examinations.
